



PORT OF PORI LTD'S WASTE MANAGEMENT INSTRUCTIONS



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Waste disposal stations for waste from the vessels arriving at the port have been marked on the attached map. Vessels are allowed to take their waste only to these waste disposal stations. In case the containers are full, please notify the Port Control, ph. +358 44 701 2623.

In case it is discovered that a vessel has left hazardous waste in containers designated for mixed waste, or elsewhere on the quay area, or if the port discovers that the vessel has sorted its waste incorrectly, the vessel will be charged for the further disposal of the waste (separation, transportation, disposal, etc.) according to the actual costs incurred.

VESSELS' SORTED MIXED WASTE

The following types of sorted waste are accepted on the territory of the Port of Pori: energy recovery waste, metals, and glass. This type of sorted waste is taken directly to the designated containers at the waste disposal stations on the quays.

VESSELS' MACHINERY OIL WASTE

The vessel or the representative of the vessel will order pick-up directly from the address oil@fortum.com.

TOILET WASTEWATER

A notification must be made to the Port Control regarding the disposal of toilet wastewater, email valvojat@portofpori.fi, ph. +358 44 701 2623, 24 hours before the intended disposal.

VESSELS' HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous waste must be taken to their designated containers, under the supervision of the port staff.

WASTE WITHOUT A DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SYSTEM

- Ballast water
- Washing water of tanks and holds
- Cleaning waste of exhaust gases
- Waste from cargo with the classification IMDG/ADR/RID
- Cargo residues

As far as this kind of waste is concerned, the vessel must order relevant services through their agent, directly from the waste management company providing these disposal services.

SORTING INSTRUCTIONS

Sort waste according to the markings on the waste containers.

ENERGY RECOVERY WASTE

Energy recovery waste denotes waste that can be incinerated.

Plastic materials with a recycling sign, as well as the number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and/or the letter combination PET, PE-HD, PE-LD, Pe, PP, PS can be disposed of as energy recovery waste:

- plastic bottles, - bags, - pads, - boxes
- polystyrene trays and covers
- lightly soiled carton packaging and bags
- textiles
- timber material, paper and cardboard that does not contain glue

The following is not suitable as energy recovery waste:

- packaging containing aluminium or other metals
- PVC plastic products
- footwear and rain clothes

WOODEN PALLETS

Only raw wooden pallets (no treated wood)

METAL WASTE

- EMPTY metal and paint tins (if these still contain chemicals, they have to be disposed of as hazardous waste)

- EMPTY aerosol bottles. Please ensure that the bottle is definitely empty
- wheels, small pieces of wire rope
- waste accumulated during metalworking

HAZARDOUS WASTE (LIQUID AND SOLID)

- solid oily waste (e.g. oil rags, oil filters, petroleum jellies, etc.)
- aerosol bottles, possibly with still some contents remaining
- oil waste
- paints and solvent waste
- fluorescent lamps
- batteries, acids and bases

INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC FOOD WASTE

Category 1 food waste originating from international traffic denotes food waste on vessels arriving into Finland from the outside of the EU, with such waste containing food scraps from meals and cooking by the passengers and the crew, as well as all other waste (wrapping papers, packaging, disposable paperware etc.) that has been in contact with the said foodstuffs or food scraps.

This waste can be put in the yellow container, separate from other waste, and packaged in a leak-proof waste bag.

SORTED LANDFILL WASTE (MIXED WASTE)

Sorted landfill waste denotes all waste left over after the above-mentioned sorting.
