

### Port of Pori Ltd. Environmental policy 2023


Port of Pori shall contribute to a long-term sustainable development by minimising the emissions to air, land and water in all our operations. The activities and services of the port concentrate on dry- and liquid bulk, recycling cargo, energy business related cargo and breakbulk cargo with associated environmental effects and impacts on air, land, water and climate change.

To minimise environmental effect and impact we shall:

1. Have an appropriate environmental management programme that guides and improves our environmental performance, focuses on the protection of the environment, and pays due regard to nature conservation.
2. Keep ourselves informed about, comply with, and as far as it is economically justified, exceed present environmental legislation and other environmental requirements to which we subscribe.
3. Work to prevent environmental incidents and maintain a high level of preparedness to reduce the effects of any incidents that may occur.
4. Use our resources as efficiently as possible and endeavour to reduce the use of energy and raw materials in proportion to the volumes handled, working towards the following specific goals: minimize the energy consumption and produce lower quantity of waste.

In order to contribute to sustainable development, we also monitor our carbon footprint by controlling our Eko Balanace.

5. Influence, specify demands and co-operate with clients, suppliers, authorities and other participants, to fulfil our environmental policy and consult adequately within the local community and relevant organisations on their environmental programmes.
6. Demand products and services that in their production, utilisation and destruction/recycling minimise the negative environmental effects.
7. Give all employees training on environmental issues and encourage them to actively regard the environment in their daily work.
8. Periodically revise the environmental policy, taking due notice of the results from completed environmental audits and changes in future conditions.
9. Make sure that all necessary resources for the implementation of our environmental policy are allocated.
10. Publish a bi-annual report (part of sustainability report Port of Pori) available to the public.
